An electric pallet truck lowers and raises the pallets by the push of a button and is often self-propelled. Being used mainly in situations where the pallets are very heavy, this unit would need regular time to recharge. Some units require that an operator walks beside the machine, while other units have a compartment for the user to ride in a standing position.

There are lift pallet trucks which are suitable for utilizing all-around shelves which are up to 1.5 meters, or up to 5 feet tall. These types of pallet trucks are capable of raising the pallet above the standard 10 inches or 25.5 cm. They likewise come in both electric and manual units.

Both types of non-powered and powered types of pallet trucks you may be considering will be specifically rated for limit weights. Lifting a pallet heavier than the machine rating specified could easily cause danger to the user, cause damage to the user and cause a voided guarantee.
